

Declaration of Conformity RoHS

European Directive 2011/65/EU "RoHS" from June 8th, 2011

The Directive 2011/65/EU, Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances, in short „RoHS“, regulates the pollutant concentration of specified hazardous substances in electrical and electronic devices. This device has been put into national legislation by the Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act.

Since June 8, 2011, limit values have been in effect for the pollutant concentrations of lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls and polybrominated diphenyl ethers for newly placed electrical and electronic devices.

The delegated guideline (EU) 2015/863 of March 31, 2015 also limited the pollutant concentrations of di (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate, butyl benzyl phthalate, dibutyl phthalate and diisobutyl phthalate for electrical and electronic devices that are newly placed on the market.

We, the ilcon GmbH, hereby confirm that our products and their components meet the legal requirements of the European Directive 2011/65 / EU RoHS, which came into force on June 8, 2011, and the delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863, which came into force entered on March 31, 2015.
